# Observer Policy for Attendees of Open Board Meetings

Reporters, members of the public, and licensees are welcome to attend open board meetings of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia as observers.

## Open board meetings

All open board attendances will be on a virtual platform, and attendees will be able to observe but not engage in any way. The cameras and microphones of observers will be automatically disabled.

Open board meetings are specifically intended to be viewed and not recorded. CPSBC does not consent to the audio or video recording of any portion of the meeting, and publication or other use of any such recording is expressly prohibited.

There may be closed portions of the proceedings where observers will be required to leave.

**There will be no comment by CPSBC regarding any of the matters that have been considered and discussed by the board.**
