# Registration Policy

## Registration Committee Ruling of Eligibility for Registration

### PURPOSE

This policy outlines the purpose of Registration Committee rulings of eligibility for registration and its time limitations.

### BACKGROUND

At its meeting on March 13, 2012, the Registration Committee adopted Resolution 12-145:

For any applications for registration received after June 1, 2009, where the Registration Committee has passed a resolution that it is prepared to grant registration to the applicant, such a resolution will be, for a period of three years, honored and used towards any subsequent request by the applicant to be registered with the College on the specific terms and conditions set out in the former resolution and on the condition that the applicant be current in practice in accordance with Bylaw 2-8.

### POLICY

Resolutions granted by the Registration Committee outline the terms and conditions of eligibility for registration and licensure including the requirements that must be met for ongoing registration and licensure.

All eligibility rulings of the Registration Committee will be in effect for a period of three years from the date they are granted unless otherwise directed by the Registration Committee or the College.
