Registration Policy

Registration Requirements for the Conditional – Practice Setting Class

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to outline the registration requirements for registrants who are eligible and wish to transfer to the conditional – practice setting class.

BACKGROUND

Section 2-22 of the College Bylaws under the *Health Professions Act* states:

Conditional – practice setting

2-22 A registrant who was granted registration in the provisional class for specialty practice with the option to be transferred to the conditional – practice setting class upon obtaining RCPSC certification may be registered in this class upon obtaining RCPSC certification subject to the limits and conditions of his or her registration.

POLICY

1. Only registrants in the provisional – specialty class who have obtained RCPSC certification in their specialty, received at least one supervisor evaluation report satisfactory to the College, and fulfilled all other registration requirements are eligible to request a transfer to the conditional – practice setting class.
2. All registrants in the conditional – practice setting class are, unless granted a waiver by the Registration Committee in exceptional circumstances, required to provide to the College a sponsorship letter satisfactory to the committee which identifies the registrant's sponsor, supervisor and how the registrant will engage in the practice of medicine.
3. The registrant's practice location will be determined by their sponsor and must be confirmed by the Registration Committee.
4. Registrants in the conditional – practice setting class of registration who wish to modify their practice location must obtain approval from their sponsor and the Registration Committee.

Registrants who were registered and licensed in the conditional – practice setting class of registration prior to December 11, 2013 and have had the requirement for ongoing sponsorship removed as a condition of their registration and licensure in this class shall continue to not require sponsorship.
