PUBLIC NOTIFICATION – February 22, 2021

Dr. NARVAS, David Eric

Vancouver, BC

- Nature of action:** The Inquiry Committee of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC (the College) conducted an investigation into the conduct of Dr. David Eric Narvas pursuant to section 33(1) of the *Health Professions Act*, RSBC 1996, c.183.
- Effective date:** February 18, 2021
- Name of registrant:** Dr. David Eric Narvas
- Location of practice:** Vancouver, BC
- Admission and acknowledgements:** Dr. Narvas has admitted and/or acknowledged the following:
 - That he failed to respond to multiple communications from the College, contrary to section 4-11 of the Bylaws made under the *Health Professions Act*.
- Disposition:** Following the issuance of a disciplinary citation pursuant to section 37 of the *Health Professions Act*, Dr. Narvas entered into a Consent Agreement with the Inquiry Committee of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC, wherein he has consented to the following terms, pursuant to section 39(2) of the *Health Professions Act*:
 - To be transferred from the Full – Family class of registration to the Conditional – Disciplined class of registration;
 - To a formal reprimand;
 - To undertake to respond to College communications within four weeks of a request for a response; and
 - To pay costs to the College in the amount of \$6,550.
- Rationale:** The Inquiry Committee was critical of Dr. Narvas' failure to respond to College communications. Given the importance that must be placed on physicians being responsive and truthful to the regulator, the Inquiry Committee determined a disciplinary outcome was appropriate.

The College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia is the licensing and regulatory body for all physicians and surgeons in the province. Governed by provincial legislation, the College's role is to protect the public by establishing, monitoring and enforcing high standards of qualification and ethical practice.
