- [Audio-Digest](#) [4] podcasts are eligible for credits through the Royal College's [MOC Program](#) [3] - podcasts, audiotapes and videotapes.
- Lectures may be claimed for credits in the CFPC in the [MAINPRO](#) [5] program.

Bibliographies - To request a bibliography on a specific clinical question from the College library, please fill out the [literature request](#) [6] form.

- CFPC members - bibliographies regarding clinical queries are eligible for step 2 of a [Pearls](#) [7] exercise.

- Royal College members - bibliographies supporting a personal learning project may be uploaded to [MAINPORT](#) [8].

BMJ Best Practice - Members of the College of Family Physicians of Canada are eligible to receive up to 20 Mainpro+ Self Learning credits for participation in this activity due to a reciprocal agreement with the Academy of Family Physicians. Clinicians can claim CME credits with BMJ Best Practice in two ways:
